

White Woman Lane Carnival 2024

Dear Parents/Carers,

On **Tuesday 9th July and Wednesday 10th July**, the whole school will be celebrating 'Carnival Day' to honour the British Caribbean Windrush generation and the different nationalities and cultures within our school community.

Throughout the day, children will be participating in activities that may involve researching the different nationalities that we have in the school and our community and creating something to share at their parade in the hall on the Wednesday afternoon (children only). Windrush day happens on the 22nd June each year and children will also be learning about this in an introductory assembly. Some year groups will be bringing in food or fruit which is traditional to their culture (please ensure that it does not contain nuts). Other year groups may be bringing in artefacts or objects.

Face painting (Snazaroo brand) will be available on Tuesday 9th July for Years 3 and 4 and Wednesday 10th July for Years 5 and 6. We kindly ask that you make a donation (minimum of £1) towards the face painting. Please pay this in advance via Parent Pay to avoid disappointment as we will not be taking cash. All proceeds will be donated towards the British Red Cross: Refugee Charity <https://www.redcross.org.uk/about-us/what-we-do/how-we-support-refugees> **IMPORTANT: Please pay a donation for face painting by Monday 8th July.** There is a risk that your child will not be included on the list for face painting if you pay after this date. A donation will need to be paid if your child wishes to have their face painted.

Children are welcome to come into school dressed in bright colours to celebrate both days which is a £1 charge (this is £1 for coming in free dress on **both** days) to go towards our school funds for future events. Please also pay this via Parent Pay.

If your child is required to bring in anything else extra to celebrate the Carnival Days, a separate letter from your child's year group will be distributed.

If your child would like a hot school dinner on the above days, there will be a bespoke lunch menu available. Please see images below for details. Lunches can also be paid for via Parent Pay. Jacket potatoes and snack packs will remain an option on both days. There is also an alternative menu for children with allergies.

We hope this will be an enjoyable day for all.
